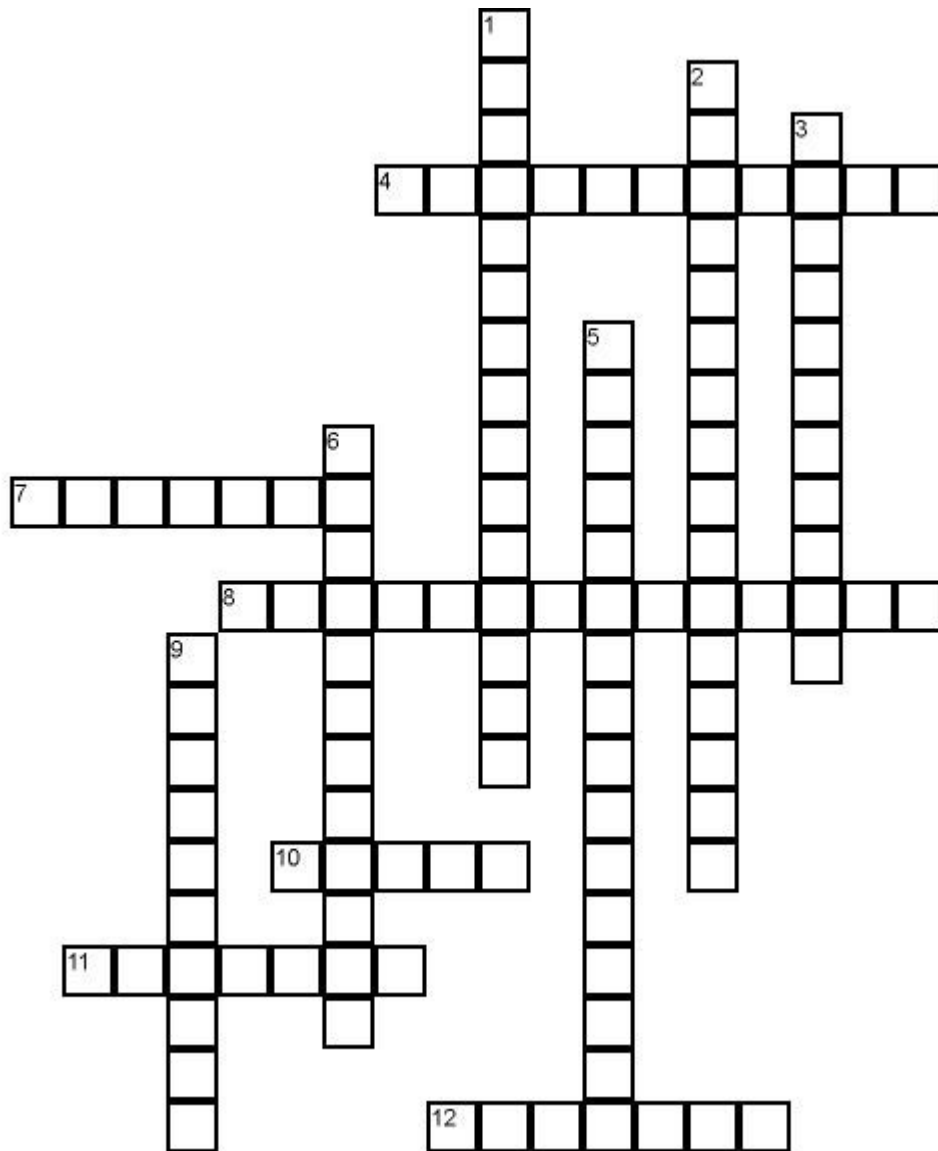


Core Values of Cub Scouting
